

## 2010 CABERNET SAUVIGNON MERLOT WILYABRUP BROOK VINEYARD MARGARET RIVER



## THE VINTAGE & WINEMAKING

Planted in 1997, the Wilyabrup Brook vineyard in the Wilyabrup sub-region of Margaret River, is a low yielding vineyard with laterite soil and a north/south orientation which is particularly well suited to the classic Bordeaux varieties of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. The fruit was picked at night on 25<sup>th</sup> March 2010. It was gently pressed and fermented over three weeks with very gentle maceration. The wine was aged in new (40%) and one year old (60%) French oak for twelve months prior to bottling. The wine is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (68.19%) and Merlot (31.81%).

## THE WINE

This wine displays complex aromas of dark fruits and cassis, with savoury hints and gentle oak support. The wine is effortlessly mouth filling with a delicate balance of fruit, acidity and gentle fine tannins leading to a long finish. It is well suited to red meat dishes such as a roast leg of lamb with garlic and herbs. It will continue to develop in the bottle for up to 10 years.
