2018 Singlefile Great Southern Botrytis

Great Southern, Western Australia

VINEYARD & WINEMAKING

The Great Southern wine region is a premier wine growing region of Western Australia. The botrytised grapes were picked in March 2018. The wine was picked and gently de-stemmed and had skin contact for 5 days. It was then pressed and settled, allowing a wild yeast fermentation to start, the fermentation ceased at 140 grams per litre. The wine was bottled in July 2018.

THE WINE

The wine displays aromas of lychee, cloves and dried orange peel. It is light bodied with a softly textured mouthfeel. Floral flavours of fresh lychee are complemented by orange blossom and lime curd, creating a subtle sweet finish with a touch of minerality.
