TASTING NOTES

2021 Singlefile Great Southern Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot *Great Southern, Western Australia*

VINEYARD & WINEMAKING

This wine is a classic Bordeaux blend of cabernet sauvignon and merlot. The fruit was picked and hand-sorted in early April 2021. The two varietal parcels were cold soaked in small fermenters for three days before undergoing an extended and gentle maceration. This was done to soften the tannins. The wine was matured in 225L Bordeaux oak barriques, 30% new, the balance went to aged Bordeaux barriques. The wine was matured in oak for twelve months before preparation for final blending and bottling.

THE WINE

This wine displays bright and lifted aromas of dark berry, cassis and dried tobacco with gentle oak support. The wine is alluring in its delicacy but also carries serious power. It is both effortlessly mouth filling with juicy red fruit flavours as well as being balanced with acidity and fine-grained tannins which lead to a long finish. It has nice palate weight and is well suited to red meat dishes such as a roast leg of lamb with garlic and herbs. It will improve with further time in bottle.
