

## 2025 Singlefile Single Vineyard Mount Barker Riesling

MOORE RIVER VINEYARD MOUNT BARKER, GREAT SOUTHERN

## Vineyard & Winemaking

The Moore River riesling vineyard was established in 1978, making it one of the most mature vineyards in the Great Southern. This Mount Barker site is dry grown, and consistently provides excellent growing conditions for dry riesling.

The 2025 season delivered good even temperatures with very little rain over the growing period. Harvest was slightly earlier than usual. The conditions were ideal for premium Great Southern riesling, which was one of the outstanding varieties of the vintage.

The fruit was handpicked and whole-bunch pressed on 17 March 2025.

The primary focus in the winery was to preserve the fruit's delicate varietal flavours and aromas. The juice was cold settled and fermented at a temperature of 14°C. It was then left to rest until preparation for bottling in July 2025.

## The Wine

The colour is light and pristine, and the aromatics display powerful pithy lime and lemon with lifted perfumes of white blossom. The palate is characterised by the powerful, natural acidic drive of the wine. Dry and elegant, the wine showcases flavours of intense lime juice and zest, with notes of lemon blossom and river stone minerality (which will develop further with bottle age). The wine has a long, refreshing finish, with a lingering lemony acidity. Well suited to be paired with natural oysters, raw seafood dishes, or spicy Asian cuisine.
