SINGLEFILE LIMITED RELEASE 'THE PHILIP ADRIAN' FRANKLAND RIVER CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2017

19 Mar, 2020 – Another impressive cabernet from this southerly section of Western Australia, showing deeply rich, ripe plum, blackberry and dark-cherry aromas and flavors with supple, sturdy and pliable tannins. Impressive. Drink or hold. Screw cap. Score: 94 Points

SINGLEFILE GREAT SOUTHERN MALBEC 2018

20 Mar, 2020 – This has very attractive red-plum and mulberry aromas with some graphite, leading to a palate that has a super silky, plush and alluring delivery of ripe dark plums. Delicious, silky malbec here. Drink or hold. Screw cap. Score: 94 Points

SINGLEFILE SMALL BATCH CLONAL SYRAH 2018

20 Mar, 2020 – Very intense and concentrated from the outset with aromas of ripe dark plums and raspberries, leading to a palate that is really saturated with deep plums and blackberries. Long, smooth tannins hold the finish. Drink or hold. Score: 94 Points

SINGLEFILE GREAT SOUTHERN ROSÉ 2019

21 Mar, 2020 – This has fresh watermelon aromas and flavors with a succulent, juicy feel to the palate. A blend of 53% tempranillo, 28% sangiovese and 19% shiraz. Drink or hold. Screw cap. Score: 92 Points

SINGLEFILE SINGLE VINEYARD FRANKLAND RIVER SHIRAZ 2018

20 Mar, 2020 – A very complex, richly fruited shiraz that delivers darkberry and red-plum aromas and flavors with a spicy and glossy feel to the sleekly defined palate. Compelling complexity and balance here. Drink or hold. Screw cap. Score: 92 Points

SINGLEFILE GREAT SOUTHERN CHARDONNAY 2019

19 Mar, 2020 – This is a beautifully fresh pear and melon style of chardonnay that has richness with a fresh, gently creamy texture on the palate. Offers flavor and freshness in equal measure. Drink now. Screw cap. Score: 91 Points

SINGLEFILE SINGLE VINEYARD DENMARK FAMILY RESERVE CHARDONNAY 2019

19 Mar, 2020 – Some additional complexity in this bottling of Singlefile chardonnay. There's plenty of fresh-pear character and some peach and apple-pastry notes with a lightly spicy edge. The palate has a very vivid feel with attractively fresh pears and apples, framed in smooth, spiced apple custard at the finish. Drink now. Screw cap. Score: 93 Points

SINGLEFILE SINGLE VINEYARD MOUNT BARKER RIESLING 2019

20 Mar, 2020 – This is an intense, fresh riesling that has a very focused, lime nose with crushed stones, too. The palate has vibrant, fresh and smooth-honed style with a gently chalky edge to the fresh green-apple finish. Drink or hold. Screw cap. Score: 93 Points

SINGLEFILE SINGLE VINEYARD FRANKLAND RIVER CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2018

17 Mar, 2020 – This has an attractive, red and blue-fruit nose with aromas of violets and blueberries, leading to a palate that has attractive density of flavor, medium body and good depth to the fresh, structured finish. Drink or hold. Screw cap Score: 93 Points

SINGLEFILE LIMITED RELEASE 'THE VIVIENNE' DENMARK CHARDONNAY 2017

This shows some development with more savory, almond and pastry aromas and flavors that build around ripe pears and peaches. The palate has plenty of depth and weight and some fine lemon flavor, too. Drink now. Screw cap Score: 92 Points
