2021 Run Free by Singlefile Riesling
Mount Barker Great Southern, Western Australia

VINEYARD & WINEMAKING

The growing season saw beautifully mild and consistent weather which encouraged optimum ripening conditions. Cooler conditions through February made the start of vintage later than usual and helped the early ripening varieties retain desirable acid levels.

This 2021 Riesling was picked in pristine conditions in March 2021. The parcels of juice underwent a long and slow cold fermentation in stainless steel tanks immediately after pressing to preserve the fruit character. The wine was bottled in June 2021.

THE WINE

The wine shows a lifted bouquet of lime and green apple. The palate displays a crisp flavoursome style with subtle minerality and a clean fresh finish.
