2019 Run Free by Singlefile Pinot Grigio

Great Southern, Western Australia



VINEYARD & WINEMAKING

The 2019 growing season in the Great southern saw plenty of rainfall and mild weather throughout which encouraged good ripening conditions. Cooler growing conditions allowed for strong varietal characteristics to shine through.

This 2019 Great Southern Pinot Grigio was picked in pristine conditions on the 9th March 2019. The fruit was destemmed and pressed, the juice transferred directly into stainless steel tanks and temperature controlled to ensure a slow fermentation process. Post-fermentation the wine was racked off fermentation lees and bottled early to retain all the delicate aromatics.

THE WINE

The wine shows a lifted bouquet of ripe pear, citrus and underlay of apricot. The palate is light and fresh and zips along to a clean and flavoursome finish.
