2016 Singlefile Great Southern Chardonnay

Great Southern, Western Australia

VINEYARD & WINEMAKING

The 2016 fruit, harvested on 12th March 2016, was chilled overnight and then fermented in 30% new and 70% one year old French oak barriques for seven months before it was bottled in November 2016.

THE WINE

This wine has bright aromas of citrus and white peach with a subtle flint character. The palate displays a modern styled chardonnay of citrus and stone fruit with judicious use of oak playing a subtle role in the background. The wine is bright and mouth filling with a tight backbone and a long lingering finish.
